Dear Parent/Guardian

The Streetly Schools Sports Day will once again be held at The Alexander Stadium, Birmingham on Wednesday, 10 June 2009.

Students should attend school as normal for morning registration in full school uniform and will then be transported to the Alexander Stadium by coach during period 1. Students, who are participating in an event during the day, including those who are reserve competitors, should arrive to school in their full PE kit.

Students must bring a packed lunch and refreshments as there will be no refreshments available to purchase on site. Students in receipt of free school meal should notify the kitchen that they would like a packed lunch for the day. Due to our unpredictable weather, we strongly advise that students bring plenty of water with them and bring sun cream to prevent the possibility of sunburn whilst competing or spectating.

As all students are representing The Streetly School can we take this opportunity to remind students that excellent behaviour must be shown at all times throughout the duration of the day. Students will remain in their form groups and in the presence of their form tutor and senior house staff, at all times.

This year our Sports Day will be run in association with Macmillan Cancer Research. Students are invited to make a minimum voluntary donation of £1.00 each in support of this charity. This money will be collected by form teachers ahead of the event.

Parents are more than welcome to join us at the stadium but all students must return back to school via the organised coaches. Students should expect to arrive back to school for approximately 2:30pm, at which stage they are allowed to leave the school site.
