

Dear Parent,

As we approach the main exam season, I would like to go over our code of conduct for exams with you.

- **We will hold our Y11 celebration assembly on Thursday, 27th May** during period 3 and 4. Once this has finished, students will be dismissed and go home. Those taking GCSE Physics will attend school on Friday; the rest will have a study day.
- **We do not give formal study leave at Streetly.** Instead, we organise a series of “booster” sessions linked to impending exams. In these sessions, staff will go over key ideas and give examples of good exam technique. These have proven to be very useful in the past and we expect **all** students to attend them.
- **A copy of the booster timetable** is on our web site. The exams are coloured green, the boosters yellow and breakfast boosters pink.
- **Students are expected to attend exams promptly.** This means being in school by at least 8.40 on the morning of an exam and 20 minutes before the start of an afternoon exam. However, we have organised a series of breakfast booster sessions to help students with last minute advice. These start at 8.00 and a light breakfast is provided free of charge for those taking part. These are indicated on the booster timetable.
- **Students are to attend exams in full school uniform**, including blazers. Students who are inappropriately dressed will be asked to sit their exam in isolation.
- **Students should come prepared with the necessary equipment**, in particular two black pens as exam boards now require these to be used.
- **Students should get a good night’s rest before each exam** and make sure they eat well and drink plenty of water.
- **If a student does not have an exam or a booster session they may study at home**, providing you are agreeable. The library and study rooms will be available for those students who need to be in school. A learning mentor will be on hand to support them.
- **Once your child has completed their final exam they will be able to leave school** provided they have returned all text books etc.
- **Our sixth form induction session** is the 5th and 6th of July.
- **GCSE results day is Tuesday, 24th August.**
